Subject: Measures and Practices for Students to Prevent the Spread of the COVID-19 during University Closure

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation, Kasetsart University has urged instructors to adopt online and assignment-based teaching and learning instead of in-person classes and unnecessary gatherings of students. The Faculty of Agriculture advises undergraduate and postgraduate students to practice as follows:

1. For undergraduate students
 - 1.1 Please ensure that you are regularly checking your emails and online messages for course-related updates and messages regarding final examinations from your instructors. If you have questions, please contact your instructors directly by telephone or online applications.
 - 1.2 For each course, please ensure that you attend all the scheduled online classes as indicated in the course syllabus.
 - 1.3 If you have any problem attending online lessons or taking online final examinations, please ask for assistance from your instructors directly.
 - 1.4 Please do not come to Kasetsart University. If you must come to campus due to your research or special problem project, please contact your advisor and take precautions by wearing a face mask and washing your hands frequently.
 - 1.5 If you would like to make other requests related to your studies, please go to the Facebook page of the Office of Educational Administration of Kasetsart University.
 - 1.6 Please submit all your assignments or completed special problem project to your instructors by email. You can send the final version of your special problem project by post after it has been approved.
 - 1.7 The general practicum (the first 150 hours) for second-year students scheduled May-June 2020 is postponed until the first university break of Academic Year 2020.
 - 1.8 Because the health and safety of students are paramount considerations, each department may reschedule the specific practicum (the second 150 hours) originally scheduled May-June 2020 and cooperative education for third-year and fourth-year students.

- 1.9 Please inform your advisor immediately if you suspect you are infected, have symptoms, or possibly been exposed to COVID-19 due to recent travel (within the last 14 days) to a high-risk destination or been in close contact with an infected person.
2. For postgraduate students
 - 2.1 Please ensure that you are regularly checking your emails and online messages for course-related updates and messages regarding final examinations from your instructors. If you have questions, please contact your instructors directly by telephone or online applications.
 - 2.2 For each course, please ensure that you attend all the scheduled online classes as indicated in the course syllabus.
 - 2.3 If you have any problem attending online lessons or taking online final examinations, please ask for assistance from your instructors directly.
 - 2.4 Please do not come to Kasetsart University. If you must come to campus due to your research or special problem project, please contact your advisor and take precautions by wearing a face mask and washing your hands frequently.
 - 2.5 If you would like to take a comprehensive examination, qualifying examination, or defense examination, please follow the procedures stated in Kasetsart University Regulations on Graduate Studies of the Graduate School, Kasetsart University, B.E. 2559 (2016).
 - 2.6 When organizing or participating in any of the above-mentioned examinations, extra precautions must be taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19, including wearing a face mask, providing and using hand sanitizer gel at the exam venue, and ensuring there is at least 1.5-meter distance between people.
 - 2.7 Please inform your advisor immediately if you suspect you are infected, have symptoms, or possibly been exposed to COVID-19 due to recent travel (within the last 14 days) to a high-risk destination or been in close contact with an infected person.

We appreciate your cooperation with all of these protective measures. Please be assured, the Faculty of Agriculture, Kasetsart University, will continue to be proactive in managing this situation to safeguard everyone's health and well-being during the current public health situation.
